SPRING CLEANUP!!!!—The snow is melting and has revealed many messes in the village. The compost site is located on the Southeast corner of the village East of the water tower. Allowed are grass clippings, leaves, flowerbed/garden debris, twigs and small branches less than 4" in diameter. **NOT ALLOWED-PLASTIC POTS, BAGS, LOGS GREATER THAN 4" IN DIAMETER, GARBAGE.** PLEASE TAKE CARE TO KEEP THE SITE OPEN-YOUR COOPERATION IS APPRECIATED!

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE ORDINANCE-

prohibits accumulation of litter, rubbish or debris on your property—this includes discarded furniture, non-functioning appliances, regular garbage/recyclables, metal and wood scraps, or any trash that presents a blighted appearance on the property of which tends to decrease the value of neighboring properties. Buildings are to remain in good repair as well. We all want our village to be a tidy place we can be proud to live. Notices will be sent to the offending owners of property when violations are observed. Penalties will be imposed for failing to clean up the property.

Thank you to those who have taken care of licensing your pet. Licenses expired on 3/31/2024. A valid rabies certificate is needed to get your dog tags. If you do not have the dog that I have on record from last year, please let me know so that I can update my records. State statute 174.12 requires dogs to be licensed---a list of unlicensed dogs are to be turned into the Taylor County District Attorney's office. A fine of \$169 is imposed for each unlicensed dog. **ALSO-- PLEASE PICK UP YOUR DOG POOP** when walking your dog on streets—it's just common courtesy to clean up after your best friend!!! ******* Once your dog is off of your property, he/she is to be on a leash.
