Collection times are every Wednesday from 5 pm to 7 pm and every Saturday from 9 am to 1 pm. **Please respect collection hours.** Drops offs are only allowed when attendants are on duty. There have been unauthorized drop-offs—there are cameras now installed!

Medford Pool Passes—The Village has made a \$200 contribution to the Medford City Pool and that allows residents of the village to buy individual or family season passes at <u>a much discounted price</u>!
