REMINDER – The village has a property maintenance ordinance that's purpose is to protect public health, safety, and welfare by establishing "minimum" property standards. We want you to be proud of this community where you live, so please do your part in keeping your property maintained! This includes cutting of long grass/weeds, and keeping your property free of litter, rubbish, old furniture, vehicles, or other debris. Penalties will be imposed for those who have been warned to clean up their property and refuse to do that. We all wish to live in a community we can be proud of!!! Visitors driving through town get their first impression of the village by what they see! \bigcirc Those in violation can expect a visit from the building inspector.

Voter registration-now is the time to pre-register on line with Wis.Vote. It's the easiest way to register or update your registration if you have any changes. You can register in clerk's office also, or on election day. Note primary is 8/13/24 and fall election is 11/5/2024.

Village Board meetings are held the 2nd Monday of month at 4:00 pm at the JMTM Library. The public is encouraged to attend.

Tire Collection at the County Highway Garage, corner of STH 13 and 64/Medford, on Saturday, August 10, and Saturday, August 17 at the Town of Holway, 8 am to noon. Fees apply. You received a flyer last month in the newsletter!

RECYCLE/TRASH collection at Village Shop: Wed., from 5 – 7 pm; Sat., from 9 am to 1 pm. Fees-\$3/bag or \$5. Barrel. Recyclables are FREE!

Chickens-annual permits are required, see website for form! Four birds, (no roosters) are allowed.

Library fundraiser--please continue to use the Finn gas pump at the Clark station to raise money for the library!

DOG LICENSE-any dog over 5 months must be licensed per state statute 174. A list will be forwarded to the district attorney of dogs that were licensed last year but have not received licenses as of this date in 2024. If you do not have your pet anymore, please let me know. Failure to comply with within 30 days will result in a \$169 fine. Dog license forms are available on the website. Intact dogs are \$15, and spayed/neutered are \$10. A current rabies vaccination certificate must be included to receive license.

EV CHARGING STATION-There is a single level 2 charging station located at the south end of pond on the south end of village near the tank. It was placed there by the Taylor Electric Cooperative. Goodwill donations are requested, and proceeds go to village funds.
