REMINDER—The village has a property maintenance ordinance that's purpose is to protect public health, safety, and welfare by establishing "minimum" property standards. We want you to be proud of this community where you live, so please do your part in keeping your property maintained! This includes cutting of long grass/weeds, and keeping your property free of litter, rubbish, old furniture, vehicles, or other debris. Penalties will be imposed for those who have been warned to clean up their property and refuse to do that. We all wish to live in a community we can be proud of!!! UTILITY BILLS—Payment is due at the end of the month to avoid late charges being assessed to your account. Contact the clerk's office if you are willing to have your bill emailed to you and if you wish to have your bill paid by auto withdrawal on the 20th (approximately) of each month! Tire Collection at the County Highway Garage, corner of STH 13 and 64/Medford, on Saturday, August 12, and Saturday, August 26 at the Town of Holway, 8 am to noon. Fees apply.

RECYCLE/TRASH collection at Village Shop: Wed., from 5 – 7 pm; Sat., from 9 am to 1 pm. Fees- \$3/bag or \$5. Barrel. Recyclables are FREE!

DOG LICENSE-any dog over 5 months must be licensed per state statute 174. A list will be forwarded to the district attorney of dogs that were licensed last year but have not received licenses as of this date in 2023. If you do not have your pet anymore, please let me know. Failure to comply with within 30 days will result in a \$169 fine. Dog license forms are available on the website. Intact dogs are \$15, and spayed/neutered are \$10. A current rabies vaccination certificate must be included to receive license.

Sewage ponds-The ponds are being treated microbially to remove the sludge from the pond bottom. It is quite an interesting process—the company guarantees that the 4'+ feet of sludge will be removed with the introduced bacteria to the pond. It is a much more cost effective and time saving process as compared to physically removing the sludge by mechanical means.

EV CHARGING STATION-There is a single level 2 charging station located at the south end of pond on the south end of village near the tank. It was placed there by the Taylor Electric Cooperative. Goodwill donations are requested, and proceeds go to village funds.
